Add at the end the following new section:

1 SEC. __. STUDY.

2 (a) REPORT.—The Attorney General shall cause a
3 scientific and medical evaluation be conducted, and make
4 recommendations based thereon, of the sort required
5 under section 201 of the Controlled Substances Act (21
6 U.S.C. 811) as to whether the substances that would be
7 placed in schedule I by this Act should be so placed.

8 (b) DELAYED EFFECTIVE DATE.—No substances
9 placed in schedule I by the amendments made by this Act
10 should be so placed unless so recommended by the Attor-
11 ney General pursuant to the study in section (a), and only
12 30 days after the issuance of the Attorney General's re-
13 port and recommendation.
