

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2278**  
**OFFERED BY MR. KING OF IOWA**

Add, at the end of the bill, the following (and conform the table of contents accordingly):

1 **SEC. 607. CERTAIN ACTIVITIES RESTRICTED.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Homeland Security  
3 may not finalize, implement, administer, or enforce  
4 the documents described in subsection (b).

5 (b) DOCUMENTS DESCRIBED.—For purposes of this  
6 section, the documents described in this subsection are the  
7 following:
