JUDICIAL COUNCIL ORDER

The Judicial Council of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit, having unanimously adopted the findings and recommendations of the report of the Special Committee filed with the Judicial Council on April 27, 2015, hereby finds that Judge Fuller's conduct "might constitute one or more grounds for impeachment under article II of the Constitution." 28 U.S.C. § 354(b)(2)(A).

Accordingly, the Judicial Council declines to dismiss the complaints, *see id.* § 354(a)(1), and the Judicial Council instead refers this finding, along with the Special Committee report and the records of these proceedings, to the Judicial Conference of the United States, *see id.* § 354(b)(2)(A).
