

# RESOLUTION

Establishing the House Committee on the Judiciary Executive Overreach Task Force of 2016

*Resolved,*

## **Section 1. Short Title**

This resolution may be cited as the “Executive Overreach Task Force Resolution of 2016.”

## **Sec. 2. Establishment of Task Force.**

There is hereby established in the House Committee on the Judiciary (hereinafter referred to as the “Committee”) a task force to be known as the House Committee on the Judiciary Executive Overreach Task Force (hereinafter referred to as the “Executive Overreach Task Force”).

## **Sec. 3. Functions.**

The Executive Overreach Task Force shall conduct hearings and investigations relating to separation of powers and executive overreach issues within the Committee’s Rule X jurisdiction, and may issue reports to the Committee detailing its findings and recommendations.

## **Sec. 4. Membership.**

The Chairman of the Committee and Ranking Minority Member thereof shall be ex officio members of the Executive Overreach Task Force pursuant to Rule 6(c) of the Rules of Procedure of the Committee on the Judiciary.

**Sec. 5. Chairman; Ranking Minority Member.**

The Chairman of the Executive Overreach Task Force shall be Mr. King (IA) and the Ranking Minority Member shall be Mr. Cohen.

**Sec. 6. Authority and Procedures.**

The Rules of the House of Representatives applicable to standing committees and the Rules of Procedure of the Committee on the Judiciary shall govern the Executive Overreach Task Force.

**Sec. 7. Expiration.**

The Executive Overreach Task Force shall expire on August 2, 2016.

**Sec. 8. Effective Date.**

This resolution shall take effect on February 3, 2016.
