With an agricultural workforce that now has a heavy foreign worker presence, reform that assists those employers who wish to uphold the rule of law is overdue.

We support the Ag Act, to help meet the growing needs of agriculture in America. By streamlining the accessibility to guest workers, North Carolina farmers, as well as those across our nation, will be able to obtain legal, dependable, farm labor to help our economies thrive.
