- 6 SEC. 2. ENHANCED PENALTY FOR STALKERS OF CHILDREN.
- 7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 110A of title 18, United
- 8 States Code, is amended by inserting after section 2261A
- 9 the following:

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1	"§ 2261B. Enhanced penalty for stalkers of children
2	"If the victim of an offense under section 2261A is
3	under the age of 18 years, the maximum imprisonment
4	for the offense is 5 years greater than the maximum term
