Dear Secretary Blinken and Secretary Mayorkas:

On May 24, 2022, federal agents arrested a 52-year-old Iraqi national, Shihab Ahmed Shihab, in connection with a plot to assassinate former President George W. Bush. Shihab, who entered the country on a tourist visa, sought to smuggle other Iraqi nationals across the southern U.S. border to aid in the assassination. Shihab also reportedly applied for asylum while attempting to commit marriage fraud in order to be able to stay in the U.S. permanently.

This arrest proves that terrorists and other bad actors continue to exploit the U.S. immigration system to do Americans harm, and that bad actors understand how the Biden-Harris Administration's open borders policies help them in carrying out horrific crimes. To assist us with our continued oversight of federal immigration policy and procedures, we ask that you please provide the following material regarding Iraqi national Shihab Ahmed Shihab:

- 1. Case history information, including but not limited to the immigration history, immigration benefits applications, and the Alien file or consular file (including consular notes).
- 2. Information regarding the time, date, and place of his entry or entries into the United States.
