Dear Mr. Hulser:

Since the 118th Congress, the Committee has been investigating former Special Counsel Jack Smith's partisan investigations into President Trump and his associates following the 2020 election. As a part of our investigation, the Committee has conducted transcribed interviews of several of Smith's prosecutors, including Jay Bratt, J.P. Cooney, and Thomas Windom.<sup>1</sup> Your testimony is vital to our investigation into how the Biden-Harris Administration weaponized the Justice Department for political purposes and misused federal law-enforcement resources.

Recently released documents raise serious new concerns regarding your involvement in the investigation. Specifically, we learned you were involved with subpoenaing phone records for several Members of Congress.<sup>2</sup> As such, we believe you possess information vital to our constitutional oversight responsibilities.

To further our oversight, the Committee requests your testimony at a transcribed interview. Please contact the Committee to schedule your transcribed interview as soon as possible, but no later than 10:00 a.m. on December 30, 2025. Pursuant to the Rules of the House of Representatives, the Committee on the Judiciary is authorized to conduct oversight of the Justice Department to inform potential legislative reforms.<sup>3</sup> If you are represented by personal counsel, please direct your counsel to contact Committee staff on your behalf.
