Dear Mr. Jammaron:

Since the 118th Congress, the Committee has been investigating former Special Counsel Jack Smith's partisan investigations into President Trump and his associates following the 2020 election.¹ Newly released documents reveal that during the Biden-Harris Administration, the Department of Justice (DOJ) subpoenaed financial institutions, including possibly Alpine Bank, for financial records of private customer data for Representative Lauren Boebert in its politicized investigations into President Trump.² As such, we write to request relevant materials in the possession of Alpine Bank.

To advance our oversight, we request that you produce the following documents and information:

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

All documents and communications for the period January 20, 2021, to January 20, 2025, referring or relating to the production or availability of financial records, information, or material to the United States Attorney's Office for the District of Columbia in relation to investigations concerning the 2020 presidential election;
2. All documents and communications for the period January 20, 2021, to January 20, 2025, referring or relating to the production or availability of financial records, information, or material to the DOJ or the Federal Bureau of Investigation in relation to the Arctic Frost investigation; and
3. All documents and communications for the period November 18, 2022, to January 20, 2025, referring or relating to the production or availability of financial records, information, or material in relation to investigations conducted by the Office of Special Counsel Jack Smith.

We respectfully ask that you produce responsive documents as soon as possible but no later than May 11, 2026. Pursuant to the Rules of the House of Representatives, the Committee has legislative and oversight jurisdiction over the DOJ and its components.³ If you have any questions about this request, please ask your staff to contact Committee staff at (202) 225-6906.
