## 1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- This Act may be cited as the "Censorship Account-

- 4 SEC. 2. RIGHT OF ACTION AGAINST FEDERAL EMPLOYEES
- 5 FOR VIOLATIONS OF FIRST AMENDMENT
- 6 RIGHTS.
- 7 (a) IN GENERAL.—A Federal employee who, under
- 8 color of any statute, ordinance, regulation, custom, or
- 9 usage, of the United States, subjects, or causes to be sub-
- 10 jected, any citizen of the United States or any person
- 11 within the jurisdiction thereof to the deprivation of any
- 12 rights, privileges, or immunities secured by the First
- 13 Amendment, shall be liable to the party injured in an ac-
- 14 tion at law, suit in equity, or other proper proceeding for
- 15 redress.
- 16 (b) Exception.—This section does not authorize a
- 17 Federal employee to bring a suit against their Federal em-

- 1 ployer or the Federal Government for conduct that is with-
- 2 in the scope of the employment relationship.
- 3 (c) Attorney's Fees.—In any action or proceeding
- 4 to enforce this Act, the court, in its discretion, may allow
- 5 the prevailing party, other than the United States, a rea-
- 6 sonable attorney's fee as part of the costs.
- 7 (d) Definition.—In this section, the term "Federal
- 8 employee" means an individual, other than the President
- 9 or the Vice President, who occupies a position in any agen-
- 10 cy or instrumentality of the executive branch (including
- 11 any independent agency).
- 12 (e) Severability.—If any provision of this Act or
- 13 the application of a provision of this Act to any person
- 14 or circumstance is held to be unconstitutional, the remain-
- 15 der of this Act, and the application of the provisions to
- 16 any person or circumstance, shall not be affected thereby.
