AMENDMENT TO H.R. 7**OFFERED BY MR. DEUTCH OF FLORIDA**

Beginning on page 2, line 8, strike title I of the bill, and insert the following (and conform the table of contents accordingly):

1 **TITLE I—EMERGENCY UNEM-**
2 **LOYMENT COMPENSATION**
3 **EXTENSION ACT**

4 **SEC. 101. SHORT TITLE.**

5 This title may be cited as the “Emergency Unemploy-
6 ment Compensation Extension Act”.

7 **SEC. 102. EXTENSION OF EMERGENCY UNEMPLOYMENT**
8 **COMPENSATION PROGRAM.**

9 (a) **EXTENSION.**—Section 4007(a)(2) of the Supple-
10 mental Appropriations Act, 2008 (Public Law 110–252;
11 26 U.S.C. 3304 note) is amended by striking “January
12 1, 2014” and inserting “April 1, 2014”.

13 (b) **FUNDING.**—Section 4004(e)(1) of the Supple-
14 mental Appropriations Act, 2008 (Public Law 110–252;
15 26 U.S.C. 3304 note) is amended—

16 (1) in subparagraph (I), by striking “and” at
17 the end;

1 (2) in subparagraph (J), by inserting “and” at
2 the end; and

3 (3) by inserting after subparagraph (J) the fol-
4 lowing:

5 “(K) the amendments made by section
6 102(a) of the Emergency Unemployment Com-
7 pensation Extension Act;”.

8 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
9 this section shall take effect as if included in the enact-
10 ment of the American Taxpayer Relief Act of 2012 (Public
11 Law 112–240).

12 **SEC. 103. TEMPORARY EXTENSION OF EXTENDED BENEFIT**
13 **PROVISIONS.**

14 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 2005 of the Assistance for
15 Unemployed Workers and Struggling Families Act, as
16 contained in Public Law 111–5 (26 U.S.C. 3304 note),
17 is amended—

18 (1) by striking “December 31, 2013” each
19 place it appears and inserting “March 31, 2014”;
20 and

21 (2) in subsection (c), by striking “June 30,
22 2014” and inserting “September 30, 2014”.

23 (b) EXTENSION OF MATCHING FOR STATES WITH
24 NO WAITING WEEK.—Section 5 of the Unemployment
25 Compensation Extension Act of 2008 (Public Law 110–

1 449; 26 U.S.C. 3304 note) is amended by striking “June
2 30, 2014” and inserting “September 30, 2014”.

3 (e) EXTENSION OF MODIFICATION OF INDICATORS
4 UNDER THE EXTENDED BENEFIT PROGRAM.—Section
5 203 of the Federal-State Extended Unemployment Com-
6 pensation Act of 1970 (26 U.S.C. 3304 note) is amend-
7 ed—

8 (1) in subsection (d), by striking “December
9 31, 2013” and inserting “March 31, 2014”; and

10 (2) in subsection (f)(2), by striking “December
11 31, 2013” and inserting “March 31, 2014”.

12 (d) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
13 this section shall take effect as if included in the enact-
14 ment of the American Taxpayer Relief Act of 2012 (Public
15 Law 112–240).

16 **SEC. 104. EXTENSION OF FUNDING FOR REEMPLOYMENT**
17 **SERVICES AND REEMPLOYMENT AND ELIGI-**
18 **BILITY ASSESSMENT ACTIVITIES.**

19 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 4004(c)(2)(A) of the Sup-
20 plemental Appropriations Act, 2008 (Public Law 110–
21 252; 26 U.S.C. 3304 note) is amended by striking
22 “through fiscal year 2014” and inserting “through the
23 first quarter of fiscal year 2015”.

24 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
25 this section shall take effect as if included in the enact-

1 ment of the American Taxpayer Relief Act of 2012 (Public
2 Law 112–240).

3 **SEC. 105. ADDITIONAL EXTENDED UNEMPLOYMENT BENE-**
4 **FITS UNDER THE RAILROAD UNEMPLOY-**
5 **MENT INSURANCE ACT.**

6 (a) **EXTENSION.**—Section 2(c)(2)(D)(iii) of the Rail-
7 road Unemployment Insurance Act (45 U.S.C.
8 352(c)(2)(D)(iii)) is amended—

9 (1) by striking “June 30, 2013” and inserting
10 “September 30, 2013”; and

11 (2) by striking “December 31, 2013” and in-
12 serting “March 31, 2014”.

13 (b) **CLARIFICATION ON AUTHORITY TO USE**
14 **FUNDS.**—Funds appropriated under either the first or
15 second sentence of clause (iv) of section 2(c)(2)(D) of the
16 Railroad Unemployment Insurance Act shall be available
17 to cover the cost of additional extended unemployment
18 benefits provided under such section 2(c)(2)(D) by reason
19 of the amendments made by subsection (a) as well as to
20 cover the cost of such benefits provided under such section
21 2(c)(2)(D), as in effect on the day before the date of en-
22 actment of this Act.

23 (c) **FUNDING FOR ADMINISTRATION.**—Out of any
24 funds in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, there
25 are appropriated to the Railroad Retirement Board

1 \$62,500 for administrative expenses associated with the
2 payment of additional extended unemployment benefits
3 provided under section 2(c)(2)(D) of the Railroad Unem-
4 ployment Insurance Act by reason of the amendments
5 made by subsection (a), to remain available until ex-
6 pended.

7 **SEC. 106. FLEXIBILITY FOR UNEMPLOYMENT PROGRAM**
8 **AGREEMENTS.**

9 (a) FLEXIBILITY.—

10 (1) IN GENERAL.—Subsection (g) of section
11 4001 of the Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2008
12 (Public Law 110–252; 26 U.S.C. 3304 note) shall
13 not apply with respect to a State that has enacted
14 a law before December 1, 2013, that, upon taking
15 effect, would violate such subsection.

16 (2) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Paragraph (1) is effec-
17 tive with respect to weeks of unemployment begin-
18 ning on or after December 29, 2013.

19 (b) PERMITTING A SUBSEQUENT AGREEMENT.—
20 Nothing in such title IV shall preclude a State whose
21 agreement under such title was terminated from entering
22 into a subsequent agreement under such title on or after
23 the date of the enactment of this Act if the State, taking
24 into account the application of subsection (a), would other-

- 1 wise meet the requirements for an agreement under such
- 2 title.
